REGULATIONS ON THE COMPETITION "GREEN CAMPUS PROJECT OF EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION"

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

1.1. The Competition "Green Campus Project of Educational Organization" (hereinafter - the Competition) is held within the framework of the International Youth School "ECOPOLIS", created with the support of the Federal Youth of the Russian Federation, on the basis of the Novosibirsk State University of Architecture and Civil Engineering (Sibstrin), Novosibirsk, Russia.

1.2. The Competition is aimed at solving upbringing and educational tasks of the National Project "Ecology", achieving the principles of sustainable development, popularizing the best practices in the field of energy and resource saving, creating a comfortable and safe environment.

1.3. These Regulations govern procedure for holding the Competition, which is voluntary and open.

2. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

2.1. The objectives of the Competition are to support youth environmental initiatives and integration between universities at the Russian and international levels.

2.2. The objectives of the Competition are:

- study of Russian and foreign best practices of green campuses in educational organizations;
- obtaining new/adaptive concepts of green campuses in educational organizations;
- promotion of the received ideas in the student and teaching environment in Russia and countries of near and far abroad, as well as in the expert community (educational and public organizations, environmentally oriented organizations and enterprises, Government structures);
- deepening universal and general professional competencies of the Competition's participants;
- environmental educational and public initiatives promotion in order to form a conscious understanding of environmental values;
- posting information about the Competition, its results in educational institutions of the city, social networks, media, etc in the idea of expanding the promotion of ecological lifestyle and environmental behavior;

- Russian and foreign youth mutual communication and receiving positive emotions, gathering useful contacts.

3. THE COMPETITION ORGANIZERS

3.1. The main Competition's organizers are:

- Federal Agency for Youth Affairs (Rosmolodezh);
- Association of "Green" universities in Russia;
- Ministry of Natural Resources and Ecology of the Novosibirsk Region;
- Department of Energy, Housing And Communal Services of the city represented by the Environmental Protection Committee of the Mayor's Office of Novosibirsk;
- Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution Novosibirsk State University of Architecture and Civil Engineering (Sibstrin) (NSUACE (Sibstrin));
- Novosibirsk Regional Association of Waste Management Enterprises "Siberian Ecology";
- Regional Office of the National Council for Corporate Volunteering in the Novosibirsk Region.

3.2. The general organization and holding of the Competition is carried out by the volunteer headquarters of the ecological club "KODAMA" under the coordination of the UNESCO Chair " Theory and Technology of Environmental Safety in Water Resources Control" NGASU (Sibstrin).

4. PARTICIPANTS OF OUR COMPETITION

4.1. Students or student teams of any directions / specialties of secondary and higher education from any regions of the Russian Federation and foreign countries aged 18 to 23, are allowed to participate in the Competition.

4.2. One can participate in both face-to-face and remote formats.

4.3. In order to participate in the Competition, you should email (e-mail-unescochair@sibstrin.ru) the following information:

- October 08, 2022 - Dead line for acceptance of the Competition's participant application for (see Appendix 1);
- October 14, 2022 – Dead line for acceptance of Your Competitive work (presentation and video)

5. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COMPETITION WORK

5.1. The Competitive work is a **project - proposal** for the organization and / or development of a Green Campus in an educational organization represented by the participants of the Competition (hereinafter referred to as the Project), which includes **five mandatory sections**:

5.1.I. **Infrastructure** of an educational organization (proposals for the organization of separate waste collection SWC, comfortable "green" spaces, energy-efficient technologies, etc.).

5.1.II. **Education** (suggestions for seminars, courses and programs aimed at training eco-professionals).

5.1.III. **Scientific research** (proposals to stimulate scientific research for sustainable development and green economy in various fields).

5.1.IV. **Administration** (proposals for the administration of an educational organization for the sustainable development strategy implementation and sustainable development management).

5.1.V. **Student activity** (proposals for the development of "green" student volunteer associations, holding eco-events and eco-festivals).

5.1.VI. **Other activity** (optional section, at the discretion of a team).

5.2. The project submitted for the Competition consists of::

5.2.1. **presentations** of no more than 20 slides;

5.2.2. **video project (no longer than one minute by its length**, including captions) created by any available means (video camera, camera, mobile phone), which discloses a project proposal for the organization and / or development of a green campus in an educational organization.

5.2.3. The video content must have a plot and it should be an original work of the Competition participants. In case of any plagiarism, the work is withdrawn from the Competition, regardless of its stage.

5.2.4. It is allowed to use photographs, animation, graphics and other expressive forms made by the Competition participants themselves for the video creation.

5.2.5. Additional video requirements:

– the video format is MP4, MOV;

– minimum resolution is 720x480..

5.2.6. Videos that violate the current legislation of the Russian Federation and / or norms of morality and ethics are not accepted for the Competition.

5.2.7. In order to submit the video to the Competition, it must be uploaded to any of the popular file hosting services with open access.

5.2.8. The video is posted on the Internet, incl. **social networks**, according to the results of the Competition.

5.2.9. Competitive video works that are not submitted on time, do not correspond to the subject of the Competition and the requirements for submitting materials, are not allowed to participate in the Competition, the submitted materials are not returned.

5.3. Projects are assessed according to the following **criteria**:

- problem understanding;
- defining the goals and objectives of the Project;
- relevance and significance of the Project;
- the Project realism;
- the Project development quality;
- efficiency of expended resources, incl. financial resources (clarity, detail, their necessity);
- the Project presentation.
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6. THE COMPETITION JURY

6.1. The Competition Jury consists of the expert community representatives from various fields (educational and public organizations, environmentally oriented organizations and enterprises, government structures).

6.2. The Jury evaluates the Projects in accordance with the criteria established by the Competition Regulations, and ranks the teams according to the final average value of the points scored.

7. IMPORTANT DATES OF THE COMPETITION

- **October 08, 2022** - Dead line for acceptance of the Competition application (see Appendix 1);
- **October 14, 2022** - Dead line for acceptance of the Competitive work (presentation and video);
- **October 20, 2022** - Dead line for the participants of the Competition to correct the competitive work, taking into account the knowledge gained, materials within the framework of the International Youth School "ECOPOLIS";
- **October 20, 2022** - Dead line for acceptance of the final Project from the participants of the Competition;
- **October 21, 2022** - **the Project defense** (video presentation), work of the Jury, determination of epy prize-winners and winners of the Competition, the results announcement, the winners awarding.

8. THE WINNERS AWARDING

8.1. As a part of the Competition, valuable prizes are awarded for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd places.

8.2. The format of the prizes is determined by the Jury, organizers, and sponsors of the Competition.

8.3. The jury, organizers and sponsors of the Competition have the right to introduce additional prizes and nominations during the Competition.
